On the **7th November** there will be a disco for children in years I to 6. Fancy dress for years I-4 with years 5-6 dressing to impress!



# **AGM**

On the 20<sup>th</sup> September there was an excellent turn out for our AGM. Mrs Fleming and Mr King gave a brief presentation about the results of the recent parent consultation as well as an update on the surprise visit by OFSTED. The new committee was then voted in and a big thank you to everybody who put themselves forward.

New Chair, Jo Humphreys, then gave a presentation about the Friends of Chase Bridge plans for the next year and explained how a new system of year group led events was hopefully going to enable more people to become involved in helping raise money for the school.

Finally, Class Rep Coordinator Carmelle Jaitly, spoke about the role of class reps and how she was going to be able to support them. The committee that was voted in was: Chair – Jo Humphreys: Treasurer – Ali Hodder-Williams: Class Reps Co-ordinator – Carmelle Jaitly: Events Management – Natalie Brown, Hermione laccarino and Kelly Batten: Marketing & Communication – Mrs Kan (staff member).

### Where Does The Money Go?

Parents are often asking how does the school spend the money we raise. Well, last year we raised an amazing £14,740.24.

Thank you to everybody who helped organise and run our events, but also thank you to all of you for turning up and spending your hard earned cash. We also need to thank Golden Grill, Tribes, Pano, Your Move, Milestone and Security Service Jagforce whose sponsorship helped our events raise even more. This is how the money was spent:

- \* Music £500 Casio electronic piano As music lessons happen in a number of areas in the school, having a portable electronic piano will enhance instrumental lessons, be used to teach piano, accompany other instruments and can be used for outside performances.
- \* Playground equipment £400 Resources to ensure a variety of games at playtime including giant tumble tower game, limbo game, outdoor chalkboard, giant wooden dominoes, ten bin bowling set, large dice.
- \* 3 year School Food Matters membership £650 Membership to this campaign helps us deliver food education and food growing programmes into school. Our 'Schools to Market' project is organised through School Food Matters, we receive a year round delivery of vegetable plug plants and they also provide a gardening workshop with an experienced school gardener.
- \* Year 3 books £291.15 Purchased The Lion and the Unicorn by Shirely Hughes to be used in the classroom.
- \* **EYFS £69.90** Butterfly raising kits from Insect Lore to support children's understanding of animal lifecycles.
- Outdoor £10,000 part funding of the Edible Playground.
- \* Lion expansion £2,829.19

#### Other activities from last year:

- We supported the Welcome BBQ and Years 6 Leavers event.
- \* We bought new events equipment such as gazebos and weights.


dads onto the dance floor to throw a few shapes! Thank you to everybody who filled in their volunteer forms and we will be in touch shortly.

Year I and Year 2 have already held their cake sales and have set the bar high. Year I raised £234.00 and were narrowly beaten by Year 2 who took just £1 more by bringing in £235.00.



# Fundraising Goals for 2019/2020



Our fundraising forecast for this year is set at £22,000. So far, we have raised £520 which along with funds rolled over from 2018/2019 will be used to support the following:

- Individual class budgets including Lions, nursery am and pm £1,200 - discretionary spending by the year groups on class items which are not covered by the school budget.
- \* An AED (defib) for the school and local community £1,247 this includes training and additional accessories.
- \* IT equipment £14,398 this will be part of a rolling programme to replace pupil laptops and other ICT resources. This year we aim to fund the first set of replacement laptops and to purchase iPads which will be used in ICT lessons.
- \* Library redevelopment £5,000 the school has exciting plans to redevelop and expand the children's library. Information about this project will be announced in due course.

There maybe other funding requests which will be under discussion and we will keep you updated should anything change. So, let's roll our sleeves up and raise as much money as we can in order that these ambitious projects can be realised.
