- ☐ Please name everything!

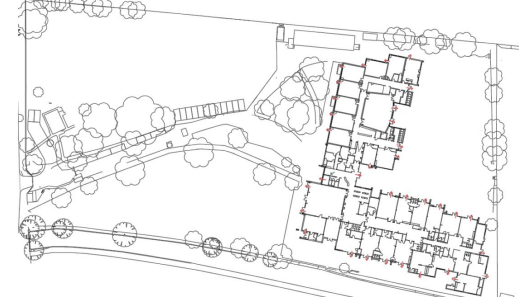


Snack Time and Lunch Time in Nursery

- ❑ 30 hours Nursery children will need to bring two pieces of fruit daily and a packed lunch too.



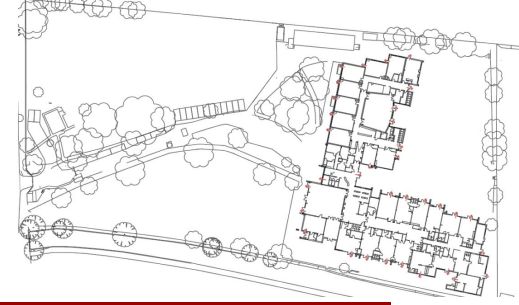
Start of the day



- ☐ AM/Full Time: 8:40
- ☐ PM: 12:15

- ☐ AM: 11:40
- ☐ PM: 3:15
- ☐ Full time: 2:45 or 3:15 (gate is open at 3:10)

- ❑ Rhyme Time
- ❑ Tuning into sounds include four aspects:

Learn the sound: What's in the box?

Practise the sound: Sound game

Blend with the sound: Blend from the box

Practise blending: Oral blending games.



Transition

- **Monday 14th July - Home Visits:** for children who do not have siblings at the school already
- **Wednesday 3rd - Thursday 4th September - School Visit:** you will be invited for a school visit with four other Nursery families.
- **Friday 5th September - Stay And Play:** the Nursery children will be invited to stay for one hour without their parents in either an AM group or a PM group.
- **September 'Settling In' Sessions:** the children will be allocated a morning or afternoon session for the settling in sessions. These sessions will be in your welcome pack.
- **Week commencing 8th September:** children will transition to life at Chase Bridge through some shorter settling in sessions. In their same AM or PM groups as before, they will come for one hour on Monday and Tuesday, two hours on Wednesday and Thursday and three hours on Friday.
- **Week commencing 15th September:** all children will be at school for their full hours. Including staying for lunch for the 30 hour children. If your child requires a personalised settling in timetable, then this can be arranged with the team.



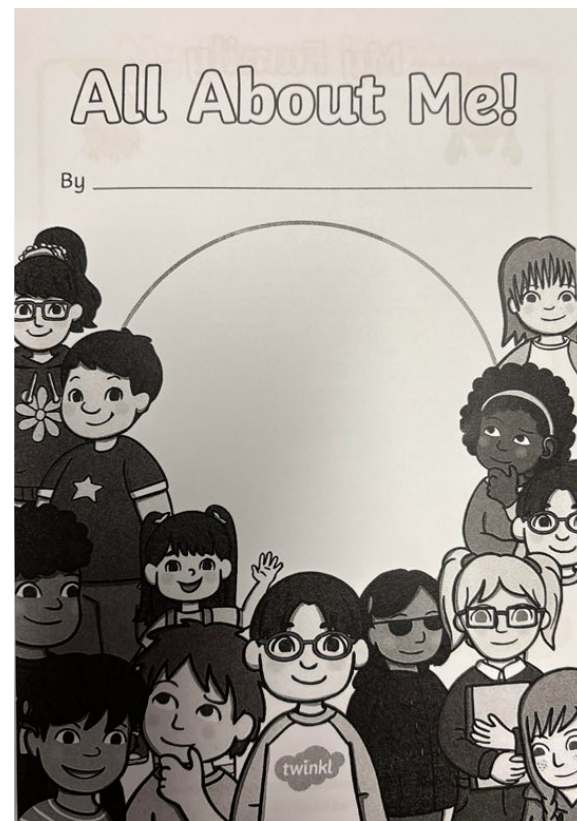
Holiday 'get ready' list
