

Home School Agreement 2025-2026

At Chase Bridge Primary School, we believe that every child is unique and everyone will be valued for who they are. Together, we will create a community where everyone feels safe, included, respected and able to thrive.

At Chase Bridge, we will:

- Promote our Chase Bridge vision Excel at learning, Express your talents, Care for others; and our values - curiosity, practice makes progress, resilience, enthusiasm, courage, self-belief, respect, compassion, responsibility.
- Support children to always be 'Ready, Respectful, Safe'.
- Support every child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive, inclusive and caring environment.
- Help and encourage every child to reach their full potential, celebrating their individual strengths and achievements.
- Monitor and communicate regularly with families about their child's progress, celebrating successes as well as working together to overcome challenges.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that reflects and values diversity, ensures equity of opportunity and is accessible to all children.
- Promote high standards of behaviour, rooted in respect and kindness, so we can maintain a
 positive and safe environment for all.
- Offer opportunities for your child to develop a sense of responsibility, build positive relationships and grow their self-esteem and confidence.
- Set home learning that supports the curriculum, is accessible for all and promotes curiosity, independence and enjoyment of learning.
 - Offer opportunities for families to feel included and engaged in school life, recognising and valuing the diverse backgrounds of our community.
 - Communicate between home and school clearly and openly, through newsletters, emails, the school website and where possible in accessible formats.
 - Respond to communications from families in a timely, respectful and supportive manner.
 - Encourage good attendance and work sensitively with families to overcome any barriers.

Parents, Carers and Guardians will:

- Support our vision and encourage our values: Curiosity, Practice Makes Progress, Resilience, Enthusiasm, Courage, Self-Belief, Respect, Compassion, Responsibility
- Support children to always be 'Ready, Respectful, Safe'.
- Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time, letting the school know if my child is absent.
- Make sure my child is dressed appropriately for learning in the correct uniform/PE kit, while recognising the school's commitment to inclusivity and individual needs.
- Work with the school to support my child in maintaining respectful and positive behaviour.
- Encourage my child to try their best so they can achieve and feel proud of their learning.
- Share with the school any concerns about my child's learning, wellbeing, or experiences that may affect them in school.
- Communicate with the school and its staff in a respectful and constructive way, recognising that we are partners in my child's education.
- Understand that staff have a healthy work-life balance and may not always respond outside core hours, though they will reply as soon as possible.
- Support my child in completing their home learning and raise any issues or concerns with their teachers.
- Read and follow the school's policies, which are designed to promote equality, safety and inclusion for all.
- Take part in meetings with the school and work in partnership with the school to achieve the best outcomes for my child.
- Read communications from school and respond where necessary, knowing that this helps us work together effectively.

Children will:

- Be 'Ready, Respectful, Safe'
- Learn to live our values every day: be curious, keep practicing, be resilient, enthusiastic, brave, confident, respectful, compassionate, responsible
- Always try my best with my work, ask for help when I need it, and celebrate what I achieve.
- Wear my school uniform/PE kit with pride on the right days, knowing it helps me feel part of our community.
- Bring what I need each day so I'm prepared and ready to learn.
- Be kind, respectful, friendly and caring towards all children and adults, and celebrate differences.
- Listen carefully to the adults at school and follow our school rules, which help everyone feel safe and included.
- Complete my home learning and bring it back on time, showing responsibility and effort.
- Look after school equipment and respect our school environment, so everyone can enjoy it.
