We offer a huge range of **extracurricular** activities:

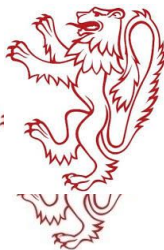
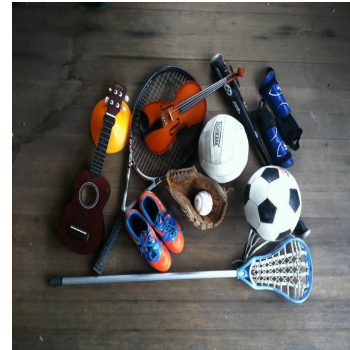
- **Sports** (gymnastics, football, basketball, rugby...)

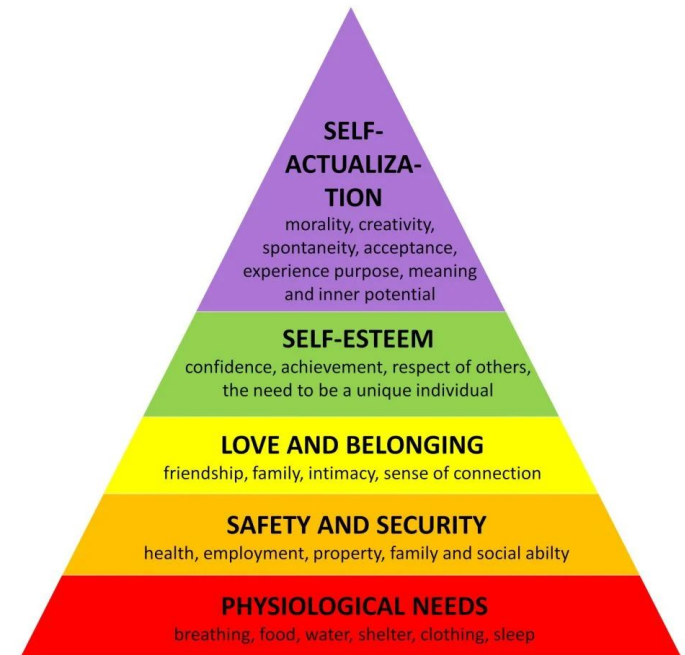
Care for others

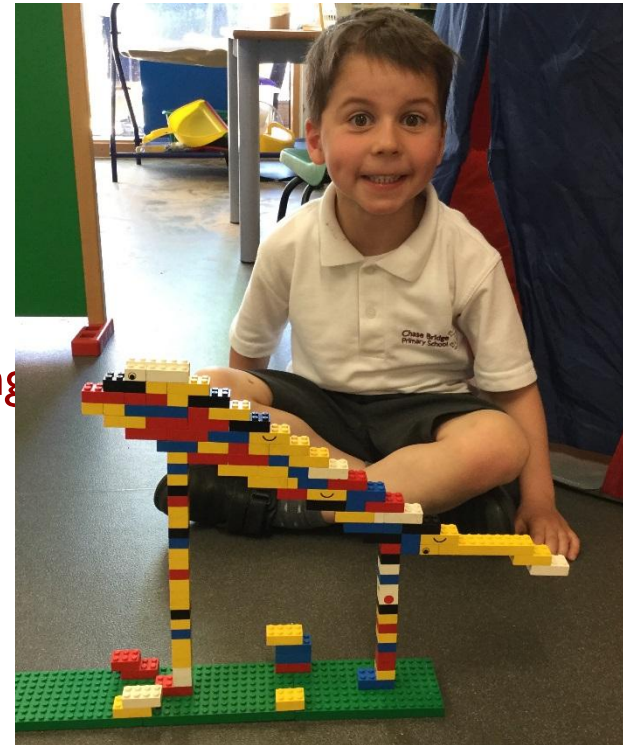

Parents as Partners

- ☐ Read to your child everyday.
- ☐ Help them to recognise their name and remember their own things such as cardigans, hats and book bags.
- ☐ Talk and play with your child and help them to share, take turns and cope with not winning.
